There is no difference in report availability and users rights.

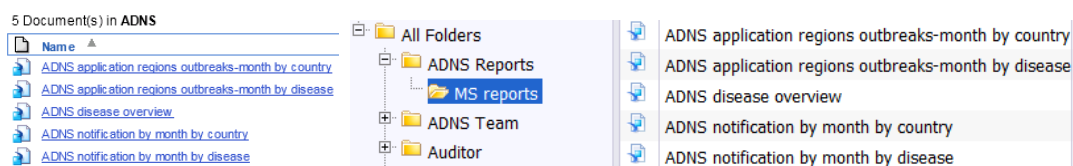


