




The animal which is entered into the EU territory must have:

- AN INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFICATION
- A VALID ANIT-RABIES VACCINATION
- A NEUTRALIZING ANTIBODY TITRATION TEST *

The identification document of the animal is the <u>EU PASSPORT</u> properly and completely filled <u>before leaving the EU territory</u> or the <u>HEALTH CERTIFICATE</u> issued by an official veterinarian or by an authorized veterinarian and endorsed by the competent authority of third country.
